

Federal Questions

Immigration

Question 1: if you are elected, will you vote to both:

- Extend protection for DACA recipients, and
- Ensure that the federal government does not separate children from their parents at the border or put families into long-term detention?

Food Security

Lead-in: The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly known as food stamps, is the single most impactful program in combatting food insecurity.

Question 2: If elected, will you vote preserve the SNAP/FOOD STAMPS program from funding cuts and harmful structural changes that would reduce access to this program by food insecure individuals and families?

Health care

Question 3: If elected, will you vote to both:

- Protect seniors on Medicare and Medicaid; and
- Restore provisions of the Affordable Care Act such as the ban on higher premiums for individuals with pre-existing conditions.

Environment

Question 4: This question about the environment is open-ended. If elected, what legislation would you propose or support to mitigate the problems of climate change?

Access

If elected will you agree to meet with Pima County Interfaith leaders within 90 days and regularly there after?

Education

Question 1: If elected, will you work to introduce and pass legislation establishing a dedicated funding stream to guarantee the state's promise to increase teacher salaries by 20% by 2020? If yes, how would you accomplish this?

Question 2: If elected will you vote for legislation that requires the same financial and educational accountability for charter public schools as for district public schools?

Question 3: If elected, will you work and vote against efforts to limit patient enrollment in AHCCCS, Arizona's Medicaid program?

Workforce

Question 4: If elected will you work to create and pass legislation to establish a state funding stream to support successful workforce development intermediaries like JobPath and Arizona Career Pathways?
